



2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 523

June 28, 2005 - Introduced by Representatives MUSSER, GARD, GUNDERSON, PETTIS, BIES, OTT, M. 1 **AN ACT** *to renumber and amend* 29.194 (1); and *to create* 29.194 (1) (b) of the
2 statutes; **relating to:** resident hunting and fishing approvals for members of
3 the armed forces.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is required to issue a resident fishing, small game hunting, or deer hunting license to a person who applies for the license and shows that he or she is a member of the U.S. armed forces and is stationed in this state.

This bill requires DNR to consider a person to be a resident of this state for purposes of receiving and paying for any noncommercial hunting, trapping, or fishing license if the person shows that he or she is a member of the U.S. armed forces or forces incorporated in the U.S. armed forces and is stationed in this state
