



## 2007 ASSEMBLY BILL 948

March 11, 2008 - Introduced by Representatives VOS, HAHN, JESKEWITZ, MONTGOMERY, MUSSER, NERISON and A. OTT, cosponsored by Senators SCHULTZ and ROESSLER. Referred to Committee on Judiciary and Ethics.

1     **AN ACT** *to create* 895.484 of the statutes; **relating to:** immunity for actions of  
2             volunteers acting on behalf of a religious association or charitable organization.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill provides immunity from civil liability to charities and religious associations for any injury or death that results from the act or omission of a person who provides services without compensation to that charity or religious association. The immunity applies when the volunteer is acting on behalf of the charity or religious association.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3             **SECTION 1.** 895.484 of the statutes is created to read:  
4             **895.484 Civil liability exemption, volunteers of religious associations**  
5             **or charitable organizations.** (1) In this section:  
6             (a) "Charitable organization" means an organization the contributions to  
7             which are deductible by corporations in computing net income under s. 71.26 (2).
