



2007 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 105

February 22, 2008 - Introduced by Representatives CULLEN, RICHARDS and ZIEGELBAUER, cosponsored by Senators SULLIVAN and TAYLOR. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Dominic Frinzi.

2 Whereas, Dominic Frinzi, a proud Italian American and a pillar of the
3 Milwaukee Italian American community, born of first generation Sicilian American
4 parents and father to three children, Joseph, James, and Dominic, passed away on
5 January 28, 2008, at the age of 86; and

6 Whereas, Dominic Frinzi graduated from Marquette University Law School in
7 1951 and served as a prominent Milwaukee attorney for more than 50 years, during
8 which time he served as a Milwaukee County circuit court commissioner for more
9 than 40 years and tried cases in each of Wisconsin's 72 counties; and

10 Whereas, Dominic Frinzi was serving his record seventh term as the president
11 of the Italian Community Center, served as president of the National Italian
12 American Bar Association, UNICO, the Italian American service organization, and
13 served as correspondent consul, to the Consul General of Italy in Chicago; and

14 Whereas, Dominic Frinzi received many awards and accolades over the years,
15 including the Justinian Society's Justinian Man of the Year Award, the Italian
