



## 2009 ASSEMBLY BILL 29

February 5, 2009 - Introduced by Representatives SCHNEIDER and VRUWINK.  
Referred to Committee on Personal Privacy.

1     **AN ACT** *to create* 100.58 of the statutes; **relating to:** the sale of consumer goods  
2             containing radio frequency identification tags.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill prohibits the knowing sale, to a purchaser in this state, of consumer goods or certain farm products that contain a radio frequency identification tag, unless the person renders the radio frequency identification tag inoperable before the purchaser takes possession of the goods or products.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3             **SECTION 1.** 100.58 of the statutes is created to read:  
4             **100.58 Consumer and farm goods; radio frequency identification tags.**  
5             **(1)** In this section:  
6                 (a) "Goods" includes all of the following:  
7                     1. Consumer goods, as defined in s. 409.102 (1) (fm).  
8                     2. Farm products, as defined in s. 409.102 (1) (ig).
