



2009 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 64

March 15, 2010 - Introduced by Senators CARPENTER, TAYLOR and COGGS, cosponsored by Representatives COLON, ZEPNICK, TOLES, PASCH, TURNER, KESSLER, YOUNG and A. WILLIAMS. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Mary Anne McNulty.

2 Whereas, Mary Anne McNulty was a champion for human rights and a
3 passionate woman who represented the near south side of Milwaukee for the 12th
4 Aldermanic District; and

5 Whereas, Mary Anne McNulty was a Chicago-raised Irish Catholic who moved
6 to Milwaukee in 1969 when she was recruited to work at the Inner City
7 Redevelopment Project; and

8 Whereas, Mary Anne McNulty was involved in politics at the national and local
9 levels and won two terms representing the 12th Aldermanic District in Milwaukee
10 in 1984 and 1988; and

11 Whereas, Mary Anne McNulty, after deciding not to seek a third full term in
12 1992, became the director of the South Side Neighborhood Center; and

13 Whereas, Mary Anne McNulty spent her whole life being a tireless advocate for
14 the poor and being a strong voice for voter and immigrant rights; and
