



2011 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 132

March 13, 2012 – Introduced by Representatives BARCA and SUDER, cosponsored by Senator MILLER. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** recognizing career and technical student organizations.

2 Whereas, career and technical student organizations (CTSO's) are a vital part
3 of Wisconsin's rich public education tradition; and

4 Whereas, there are many participating CTSSO's in Wisconsin, including the
5 Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA), DECA, Family, Career and
6 Community Leaders of America (FCCLA), Wisconsin Future Farmers of America
7 (FFA), and the Health Occupations Students of America (HOSA); and

8 Whereas, over 40,000 students and 800 chapters have participated in CTSSO's
9 in a single year; and

10 Whereas, these programs help to develop the future business and civil
11 leadership of Wisconsin through community service and competitive activities; and

12 Whereas, involvement in CTSSO's promotes academic and civic engagement,
13 self-efficacy, and employment skills in participating members; and

1 Whereas, CTSO's provide invaluable resources and time to charities statewide,
2 including raising over \$80,000 in support and donating over 15,000 hours in
3 volunteer efforts; now, therefore, be it

4 ***Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That*** the legislature
5 applauds and encourages leaders to support the efforts of career and technical
6 student organizations in developing the future leaders of Wisconsin; and, be it
7 further

8 ***Resolved, That*** the assembly chief clerk shall provide a copy of this joint
9 resolution to participating career and technical student organizations.
