



## 2011 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 43

June 2, 2011 – Introduced by Representatives FARROW, BERNIER, BROOKS, KRAMER, KUGLITSCH, MOLEPSKE JR, SPANBAUER, STEINEKE and TRANEL, cosponsored by Senators VUKMIR, GALLOWAY, KEDZIE, LASSA, LAZICH and MILLER. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1     **Relating to:** the life and public service of Sheriff Raymond Klink.

2             Whereas, Sheriff Raymond Klink was born on July 23, 1930, in North Lake,  
3     Wisconsin, and died on January 17, 2011, a lifelong resident of Waukesha County;  
4     and

5             Whereas, Ray served his community with great distinction as a law  
6     enforcement officer in Waukesha County for over 35 years; and

7             Whereas, Ray began his career in law enforcement in 1958 when he joined the  
8     Waukesha County Sheriff's Department; and

9             Whereas, Ray was elected to the position of Waukesha County Sheriff in 1978;  
10     and

11             Whereas, Ray was instrumental in advancing the mission and goals of the  
12     department, including hiring Waukesha County's first female deputy in 1979,  
13     instituting both the D.A.R.E. Program and Metro Drug Unit in Waukesha County,  
14     and raising private funds to begin a canine unit; and
