2 Whereas, 2014 marks the 103rd annual International Women's Day, first
3 celebrated in Europe, and endorsed since the 1970s with annual proclamations by
4 the President of the United States and internationally by the United Nations
5 General Assembly; and

6 Whereas, International Women's Day is observed around the world to celebrate
7 the social, political, and economic achievements of women while focusing world
8 attention on areas requiring further action, finding that empowering women to
9 participate fully in economic life across all sectors is essential to build stronger
10 economies and improve the quality of life for women, men, families, and
11 communities; and

12 Whereas, on this day, we celebrate advancements in the social and economic
13 status of women in Wisconsin, including achievement of high levels of educational
14 attainment, business ownership, and leadership in our state; and
