2             Whereas, Dr. Martin Jack Rosenblum passed away suddenly in his sleep on  
3     January 10, 2014, at the age of 67; and

4             Whereas, Martin was the beloved husband of Maureen Rosenblum and the  
5     cherished father of Sarah Terez Rosenblum and Molly Dvora Rosenblum; and

6             Whereas, Martin spent his teenage years in a prodigy program at Lawrence  
7     University in Appleton, Wisconsin, studying classical music; and

8             Whereas, Martin was an Appleton, Wisconsin, native who earned a B.A. in  
9     English from the University of Wisconsin–Madison, and an M.A. in Creative Writing  
10    and a Ph.D. in literature from the University of Wisconsin–Milwaukee; and

11            Whereas, Martin served at UW–Milwaukee for over thirty years, teaching  
12    poetry, creative writing, and music courses to thousands of students during that  
13    time; and
