



## 2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 404

October 13, 2015 – Introduced by Representatives SKOWRONSKI, WEATHERSTON, SUBECK and ZEPNICK, cosponsored by Senator C. LARSON. Referred to Committee on State Affairs and Government Operations.

1     **AN ACT to amend** 125.06 (6) and 125.09 (6) of the statutes; **relating to:** the sale  
2           of alcohol beverages by a municipality or county in a park.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, with limited exceptions, no person may sell alcohol beverages to a consumer unless the seller possesses a license or permit authorizing the sale. Under one exception, no license or permit is required for the sale, by officers or employees of a county or municipality, of fermented malt beverages (beer) in a public park operated by the county or municipality.

This bill applies this exception to all alcohol beverages (beer, wine, and distilled spirits), not just to beer.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3           **SECTION 1.** 125.06 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:  
4           125.06 (6) PUBLIC PARKS. The sale of ~~fermented malt~~ alcohol beverages in any  
5           public park operated by a county or municipality. ~~Fermented malt~~ Alcohol beverages  
6           shall be sold by officers or employees of the county or municipality under an  
7           ordinance, resolution, rule, or regulation enacted by the governing body.
