2019 SENATE BILL 559

November 8, 2019 - Introduced by Senators NASS, COWLES and OLSEN, cosponsored by Representatives HORLACHER, DITTRICH, KRUG, LOUDENBECK, PLUMER and TUSLER. Referred to Committee on Labor and Regulatory Reform.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 33.22 (1) of the statutes; **relating to:** bid requirements for
2 public inland lake protection and rehabilitation districts.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a lake protection and rehabilitation district may be created to carry out a program of lake protection and rehabilitation. Under current law, the district must let to the lowest responsible bidder any contract in excess of \$2,500 for the performance of any work or the purchase of any materials. This bill increases this threshold to \$10,000.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 33.22 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 33.22 (1) Any district organized under this chapter may select a name for the
5 district, sue and be sued, make contracts, accept gifts, purchase, lease, devise or
6 otherwise acquire, hold, maintain or dispose of property, disburse money, contract
7 debt, and do any other acts necessary to carry out a program of lake protection and
8 rehabilitation. All contracts in excess of ~~\$2,500~~ \$10,000 for the performance of any
