2021 ASSEMBLY BILL 632

October 21, 2021 - Introduced by Representatives DITTRICH, GUNDRUM, PENTERMAN, MURSAU, SNYDER, THIESFELDT, TUSLER and DOYLE, cosponsored by Senators WIMBERGER, MARKLEIN and BALLWEG. Referred to Committee on Family Law.

1 **AN ACT** *to renumber* 809.107 (5) (am); *to amend* 809.107 (5) (am) (title); and *to*
2 *create* 48.43 (6) (am) and 809.107 (5) (am) 2. of the statutes; **relating to:** duty
3 to participate in an appeal of an order terminating parental rights.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a duty for an appellant who has filed an appeal of an order terminating his or her parental rights, to participate in that appeal. The bill allows any person who receives a notice of intent to file an appeal of an order in a termination of parental rights (TPR) proceeding to petition the court to find that the appellant has abandoned the proceeding if the appellant does not fulfill his or her duty to participate. Under current law, the appellant may file a notice of abandonment if he or she decides not to pursue the appeal.

4 **SECTION 1.** 48.43 (6) (am) of the statutes is created to read:
5 48.43 (6) (am) A person who appeals an order terminating his or her parental
6 rights under this section has a duty to participate in the appeal.
