



2021 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 147

March 10, 2022 - Introduced by Representatives KRUG and SHANKLAND. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** recognizing Wisconsin Water Week 2022.

2 Whereas, water is vitally important to all of us in Wisconsin as a requirement
3 of our daily lives; and

4 Whereas, water is also central to Wisconsin's success as a center of tourism,
5 agriculture, food production, and industry; and

6 Whereas, our state's lakes, rivers, streams, and wetlands provide habitat to
7 wildlife and benefit the people of Wisconsin with ample recreation and sporting
8 opportunities, and the health of these waters serves all of us in the state, from flood
9 protection to quality of life; and

10 Whereas, healthy waters are culturally recognized by Wisconsin Native
11 Nations, including elders, tribal councils, water walkers, and conservation
12 professionals, as a critical foundation for maintaining traditional ways and
13 ceremonies, sustaining hunting and fishing territories, and retaining a bright future
14 for our next generations; and
