



2021 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 71

October 21, 2021 - Introduced by Senators TESTIN, BRADLEY, BALLWEG, DARLING, FELZKOWSKI, KAPENGA, MARKLEIN, STROEBEL and WANGGAARD, cosponsored by Representatives DUCHOW, LOUDENBECK, ALLEN, CABRAL-GUEVARA, DALLMAN, DITTRICH, GUNDRUM, HORLACHER, JAMES, KITCHENS, KRUG, KUGLITSCH, KURTZ, MAGNAFICI, PENTERMAN, PLUMER, ROZAR, SPIROS, TITTL, VORPAGEL, WICHGERS, WITTKE, ZIMMERMAN, EDMING, SCHRAA and THIESFELDT. 1 **Relating to:** proclaiming October 2021 to be Right to Life Month in Wisconsin.

2 Whereas, the U.S. Constitution and the Wisconsin Constitution enshrine the
3 right to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness; and

4 Whereas, it is the duty of government to protect the unalienable right to life of
5 every person within both the state and the nation; and

6 Whereas, the life of every innocent child—born or unborn—must be preserved,
7 protected, and defended; and

8 Whereas, as recently as 2017, approximately 862,320 abortions were
9 performed in the United States in one year, of which 6,360 were performed in
10 Wisconsin; and

11 Whereas, advocates of the Right to Life movement have consistently and
12 vocally expressed their opposition to abortion as a moral wrong and a public outrage;

14 Whereas, the Right to Life movement recognizes the right of medical
15 professionals to refuse participation in a practice that extinguishes human life; and
