



2023 ASSEMBLY BILL 967

January 16, 2024 - Introduced by Representatives TUSLER and ORTIZ-VELEZ, cosponsored by Senators WANGGAARD and TAYLOR. Referred to Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety.

1 **AN ACT to create** 19.36 (14) of the statutes; **relating to:** withholding judicial
2 security profiles from public access.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill exempts a judicial security profile form from disclosure under the public records law. Under the bill, a judicial security profile form is a form completed by or on behalf of a current or former judicial officer, such as a judge or court commissioner, and used to develop an emergency response plan.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 19.36 (14) of the statutes is created to read:
4 19.36 (14) JUDICIAL SECURITY PROFILES. (a) In this subsection:
5 1. "Judicial officer" means any of the following, whether living or deceased:
6 a. A justice or former justice of the supreme court.
7 b. A judge or former judge of the court of appeals.
8 c. A judge or former judge of any circuit court.
