



2023 SENATE BILL 1095

March 27, 2024 - Introduced by Senator WIRCH, cosponsored by Representative BALDEH. Referred to Committee on Universities and Revenue.

1 **AN ACT to create** 20.835 (2) (cd) of the statutes; **relating to:** providing a tax
2 rebate for 2024.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a onetime tax rebate payable in 2024. Under the bill, all individuals filing an individual income tax return for the 2023 tax year will receive a rebate payment of \$982, and married persons filing a joint return will also receive a rebate payment of \$982. The bill provides that all rebate payments be made no later than December 31, 2024. Under the bill, a nonresident or part-year resident is not eligible for the rebate.

3 **SECTION 1.** 20.835 (2) (cd) of the statutes is created to read:
