WISCONSIN TERRITORY.

AN ACT to amend "an act authorizing Webster Stanley to maintain a ferry across Fox river," approved Feb. 18, 1842.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

§ 1. That Webster Stanley is hereby authorized to keep and maintain a ferry across the Fox river, in the county of Brown, on section twenty-four, in town eighteen north, of range eighteen east, for such length of time, and subject to such restrictions, as are provided by the act which is hereby amended.

Re-considered, and passed the House of Representatives, March 20, 1843, by ayes and noes, nineteen members voting for the bill.

AN ACT to organize certain towns therein named:

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

§ 1. That all that part of the town of Warren, in the county of Milwaukee, comprised in township seven, in range eighteen east, is hereby set off and organized into a separate town, by the name of Nemahbin; and the first election in said town shall be held at the house of N. P. Hawks.

§ 2. That all that part of the town of Spring Prairie, in Wal-lah Fayette north county, comprised in township three, range seventeen east, is hereby set off and organized into a separate town by the name
