AN ACT to authorize the Supervisors of Brown
County to raise money for certain improvements,
and for other purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of
the Territory of Wisconsin:*

SECTION 1. That the supervisors of Brown county, shall have
Supervisors to power and they are hereby required to levy a tax not exceeding
levy one per cent. one per cent, per annum annually, for the purpose of construct-
ing a McAdam, plank, rail or turnpike road, from the foot of the
Grand Kakalin to Winnebago Lake as may be deemed most ex-
pedient.

SEC. 2. The said tax shall be levied and collected at the same
How levied and collected time, and in the same manner that taxes are by law required to
be levied for the support of county government, in said county;
and said tax shall be a lien on real estate on which the same is or
may be assessed until paid: *Provided*, however, that the tax au-
thorized to be collected by this act, shall be paid in money to the
several collectors, and paid by them in like funds to the county
treasurer.

SEC. 3. The said board of supervisors are hereby authorized
How appropri- and required to appropriate all the moneys raised in pursuance of
ated. this act, to the purposes herein expressed, and no other. And
the said board are further authorized to cause such road to be loca-
ted, and surveyed by persons appointed by them, and having deter-
mined upon the location and survey, and upon the kind of improve-
ment to be constructed, to give out contracts for the construction
thereof, as they may deem most for the interest of said county:
Proviso. *Provided*, however, that the cost and location of such survey, and
other expenses attending the same shall not exceed one hundred
dollars.

SEC. 4. This act shall be submitted to the people of said
This act sub-

county, at the elections to be held in April of each year, and if a ^{majority of the} ~~majority of~~ all the votes cast at such election in the several towns, ^{limited to the} ~~people.~~ shall be in favor of raising said tax, then the said board of supervisors are required to carry this act into effect; but if a majority of all the votes cast at such election, shall be against raising said tax, then the said tax shall not be levied during the year such vote was given. And it shall be the duty of the inspectors of election in each town, to return to the board of supervisors of the county, on or before the first Monday of May in each year, a certificate stating the number of votes given for and against raising said tax in the town meeting at which they presided.

SEC. 5. In case the people of the said county of Brown, shall ^{People may} ~~change~~ their form of county government in the manner contemplated by law, then the electors of said county, ^{vote for or} ~~may~~ vote for or against the tax proposed to be levied by this act at the annual election, which votes shall be canvassed as the law requires in relation to county officers, and if a majority of the votes shall be in favor of the same, then the proper county officers for the ensuing year, shall be required to levy and assess and to appropriate the same according to the provisions of this act.

AN ACT to incorporate the Stockholders of the Janesville Academy.

*Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of
the Territory of Wisconsin:*

SECTION 1. That there be established in the village of Janesville, a seminary of learning, by the name of the Janesville Academy, and A. Hyatt Smith, John J. R. Pease, Edward V. ^{Who incorpo-} ~~Whitton,~~ and such persons as may associate with them, ^{rators, &c.} ~~be,~~ and they are hereby created a body politic and corporate, by the name and style of the Stockholders of the Janesville Academy, by which name they and their successors shall be forever known, and have perpetual succession, and shall have power to contract and be contracted with, sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, defend and be defended in all courts of law or equity, in all actions, suits, causes and complaints whatever; and they shall have a common seal, ~~and~~ they shall have power under such corporate name, to ac-
