

AN ACT to provide for the payment of Horatio N. Wells' account against the Territory.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. There shall be allowed and paid to Horatio N. Wells, out of the territorial treasury, one hundred and eighty-five dollars for services rendered in 1842, '3, in three several suits of the Territory vs. Doty and others, which sum shall be in full for all services up to this date.

APPROVED February 2, 1846.

AN ACT fixing the salary of the Attorney General.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That the Attorney General of the Territory shall be allowed and paid an annual salary of two hundred any fifty dollars from and after the first day of July. A. D. 1845, and the Auditor of the Territory shall issue warrants on the Treasurer for said salary quarterly, if required: *Provided*, That there shall not be allowed to the Attorney General any compensation for services already rendered, except as provided in this act.
