

AN ACT

To divorce Samuel Hall from his wife Sarah Hall.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That the marriage contract between Samuel Hall and his wife Sarah Hall is hereby dissolved, and the parties to the said contract are by virtue of this act restored to all the rights and privileges of unmarried persons.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
