AN ACT to change the name of the town of Mentor, in the county of Milwaukee.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin.

SECTION 1. That the town now called Mentor in town six range twenty, in the county of Milwaukee, shall hereafter be called New Berlin.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

AN ACT limiting the term of office of all officers of this Territory, not now limited by law.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin, as follows:

SECTION 1. The term of office of all officers of this Territory, whose terms are not now limited by law, (except militia Of certain officers, term of office limited to two years. officers) shall be two years; and the term of all such officers (except militia officers) now under commission, shall terminate and expire on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-two.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after the fifteenth day of January, eighteen hundred and forty.

AN ACT relating to the duties of the Register of Deeds of the county of Rock.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin,* That it is hereby made the duty of the Register of Deeds of the county of Rock, to procure from the Records of the Registers of Deeds, of Register of Rock to procure copies of records of Milwaukee and Racine Registers
