

An Act to appropriate money for the purpose therein mentioned.

Chap. 319

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to the Secretary of State, for postage paid from the first day of January to the fourth day of November, eighteen hundred and fifty, the sum of ninety-six dollars and two cents. To Secretary of State for postage.

SEC. 2. To Chauncey Abbott, Postmaster at Madison, the sum of ninety dollars and eighteen cents for postage of the offices of Secretary of State and State Superintendent from the fourth day of November, eighteen hundred and fifty, to the seventh day of March, eighteen hundred and fifty-one; and such further sum to the Postmaster at Madison, not exceeding three hundred dollars, as may be necessary to pay the postage of the offices of Secretary of State, State Treasurer, and State Superintendent, to be drawn quarterly upon the presentation of postage amounts, properly certified by their respective officers. To Chauncey Abbott for postage.

An Act to appropriate to Beriah Brown the sum therein named.

Chap. 320

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Beriah Brown, to be paid out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two hundred and twenty-five dollars and thirty cents, in full, for publishing in the *Wisconsin Democrat* proposals for printing proclamation of Governor for special election in Racine county, notice of sale of water power in Milwaukee, general election notice, thanksgiving proclamation, Governor's proclamation for special election in Kenosha county, and for publishing forty-four laws passed at the present session of the legislature, by order of the Secretary of State.
