An Act to appropriate to James Heepin the sum therein named.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to James Heepin, to be paid out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one hundred and eighty-two dollars, in
