Chap. 33. An Act to amend an act entitled "an act providing for the sale of the school section in the city of Racine."

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows .

Section 1. The time of payment of the purchase money secured to be paid to the State of Wisconsin by bonds and mortgages on the sale of said school section is hereby extended to become due and payable in one or more instalments at any time within ten years from the time of such sale at the option of the purchaser—the interest accruing on said bonds and mortgages to be paid in advance on the first day of January or within thirty days thereafter in each year, at the State Treasurer's office in Madison.

An Act to extend the time for collecting taxes in the town of Brooklyn, Sank County.

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate

The time for collecting the taxes in the town of Brooklyn, Sauk County, is hereby extended to twenty days beyond the time now required by law, and the Treasurer of said Town shall have the same right to levy on property and sell the same within said time so extended, as is now allowed by law for such purposes:
