

An Act to appropriate a certain sum of money to Leonard J. Farwell, for the use of William H. Wallis. Chap 465

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Leonard J. Farwell, Governor of the state of Wisconsin, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one hundred and ninety-four dollars, for the use and benefit of William H. Wallis, (a minor) to be laid out and expended by the said governor for the use and benefit of said William H. Wallis, and to be in full pay for enrolling done by the said Wallis during the present session of the legislature *Provided*, That so much of the amount herein appropriated shall be paid to Mr. Fryer as the said Fryer has paid to William H. Wallis for services rendered for this legislature.

An Act to appropriate to Beriah Brown a certain sum of money.

Chap 466

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Beriah Brown, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of two thousand four hundred and three dollars and twenty-five cents, in full, being the amount due for incidental printing of the two houses of the legislature for the year 1852, and for newspapers furnished to the members of both houses up to the close of the present session.
