

An Act to apportion and district anew the members of the Senate and Assembly of the State of Wisconsin. **Chap 499**

*The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. Until there shall be a new apportionment, the senators and members of the assembly shall be apportioned among the several districts of this state as is hereinafter mentioned ; and each district shall be entitled to elect one senator or member of the assembly as the case may be. Senators and members of assembly apportioned.

The counties of Sheboygan, Calumet, and Manitowoc shall constitute the first senate district. 1st senate district.

The counties of Brown, Door, Outagamie, Oconto, Waupaca, Marathon, and Portage, shall constitute the second senate district. 2d.

The towns of Mequon, Cedarburg, Grafton, Port Washington, Saukville, Fredonia, and Belgium, in the county of Washington, shall constitute the third senate district. 3d.

The towns of Erin, Richfield, Germantown, Jackson, Polk, Hartford, Addison, West Bend, Newark, Trenton, Farmington, Kewaskum, and Wayne, in the county of Washington, shall constitute the fourth senate district. 4th.

The first and second wards of the city of Milwaukee, and towns of Wauwatosa, Milwaukee, and Granville, in the county of Milwaukee, shall constitute the fifth senate district. 5th.

The third, fourth, and fifth wards in the city of Milwaukee, and the towns of Greenfield, Lake, Oak Creek, and Franklin, in the county of Milwaukee, shall constitute the sixth senate district. 6th.

The county of Racine shall constitute the seventh senate district. 7th.

The county of Kenosha shall constitute the eighth senate district. 8th.

The towns of Eldorado, Lamartine, Oakfield, Fond du Lac, and Friendship, and the city of Fond du Lac, in the county of Fond du Lac, shall constitute an assembly district.

The towns of Calumet, Forrest, Taycheedah, Kossuth, and Empire, in the county of Fond du Lac, shall constitute an assembly district.

**Winnebago**

Townships seventeen and eighteen, ranges fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, and seventeen, in the county of Winnebago, shall constitute an assembly district.

Townships nineteen and twenty, in ranges fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, and seventeen, in Winnebago county, shall constitute an assembly district.

**Dodge.**

The towns of Leroy, Lomira, Williamstown, and Theresa, in the county of Dodge, shall constitute an assembly district.

The towns of Hubbard, Hermon, Hustisford, and Rubicon, in the county of Dodge, shall constitute an assembly district.

The towns of Emmett, Lebanon, and Ashippon, in the county of Dodge, shall constitute an assembly district.

The towns of Elba, Lowell, Clyman, Portland, and Shields, in the county of Dodge, shall constitute an assembly district.

The towns of Fox Lake, Trenton, Westford, Calamus, and Beaver Dam, [in the county of Dodge,] shall constitute an assembly district.

The towns of Chester, Burnette, and Oak Grove, in the county of Dodge, shall constitute an assembly district.

**Marquette and Waushara.**

The towns of Berlin, Brooklyn, Pleasant Valley, Middleton, Mackford, Albany, and Green Lake, in the county of Marquette and the county of Waushara, shall constitute an assembly district.

All of that portion of Marquette county being west of

the range line between ranges ten and eleven east, and the towns of Marquette and Kingston, in the county of Marquette, shall constitute an assembly district.

The counties of Sauk and Adams shall constitute an assembly district. Sauk and Adams.

The county of Green shall constitute an assembly district. Green.

The towns of Fort Winnebago, Port Hope, Marcellon, Scott, Randolph, Portage Prairie, Spring Vale, and Wyoceña, in the county of Columbia, shall constitute an assembly district. Columbia.

The towns of Columbus, Fountain Prairie, Hampden, Otsego, Leeds, Lowville, Lodi, Dekorra, West Point, and Caledonia, in the county of Columbia, shall constitute an assembly district.

SEC. 2. At the general election in November, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty-two, there shall be elected in the fourth, tenth, and eighteenth senate districts, each, as above described, a state senator, whose term of office shall expire on the day preceding the first Monday in January, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four. Senators to be elected.

An Act to amend section fifteen of chapter seventy of the Revised Statutes, and to extend the provisions of said section.

Chap 500

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section fifteenth of chapter seventy of the revised statutes is so amended as to authorize and allow action to be commenced against executors and administrators to perfect a lien of any mechanic and laborer for work done, and for materials furnished by any brick maker, brick layer, stone cutter, mason, lime merchant, carpenter, painter, glazier, iron monger, plasterer, lumber merchant, and to any person employed in erecting or repairing any house or other building.
