

Chapter 80.[*Published April —.*]

An Act to amend an act to give effect to an act entitled an act to amend chapter 86 of the revised statutes, and for other purposes, approved, April 3d, 1854, relating to county courts, approved, February 28, 1855.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section eight (8) of said act, approved Feb- Sec. amended.
 ruary 28, 1855, is hereby so amended as to read as follows:
 "This act shall not apply to the counties of Milwaukee
 and La Crosse.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its pas-
 sage.

Chapter 81.[*Published April 20.*]

An Act to provide for defraying the contingent expenses of the state for the present year, and to repeal section 8, of chapter 9, of the revised statutes, which appropriates six hundred dollars for the same object.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of defraying the contingent Appropriation

state. expenses of the state for the present year, the sum of five thousand dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be drawn from the treasury by and expended under the direction of the Governor, as the exigencies of the public service may require, and it is hereby made the duty of the Governor to cause to be transmitted to the next legislature at the opening of the session thereof, a detailed statement of the expenditure of this appropriation.

SEC. 2. Section 8, of chapter 9, of the revised statutes, Sec. repealed...
 which appropriates the sum of six hundred dollars, and all other acts making appropriations for the objects provi-
