An Act to provide for more fully carrying into effect the General Banking Law of this State.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Bank comptroller to apregister.

Section 1. The bank comptroller is hereby authorized point assistant to appoint one assistant register, who shall be accountable to and perform such duties as may be assigned him by the bank comptroller, and shall receive an annual salary of six hundred dollars, to be paid by the state treasurer quarterly, commencing on the first day of January last.

Clerk.

SEC. 2. The state treasurer is hereby authorized to appoint one clerk, who shall perform such duties in the bank department as may be assigned by the state treasurer.— He shall receive an annual salary of six hundred dollars, to be paid out of the state treasury quarterly, commencing on the first day of January last.

Agent

SEC. 3. The agent of the bank department in the city of New York, shall receive an annual salary of five hundred dollars, to commence on the first day of January, 1856, and to be paid by the state treasurer, on the certificate of the bank comptroller. The salary of the bank register is hereby increased to the sum of twelve hundred dollars.

Appropriation.

SEC. 4. A sum sufficient to provide for the payment of the foregoing appropriations is hereby annually appopriated, to be paid out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.
