An Act to provide for the payment for Supreme Court reports for the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty four.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Secretary of
state to audit
an account.

SECTION 1. That the secretary of state is hereby authorized and required to audit the account of the reporter, for two hundred copies of the reports of the supreme courts for the year eighteen hundred and fifty four, at the publisher's prices.

Payment.

SEC. 2. That the sum so audited and allowed shall be paid out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

An Act to amend section ninety-three, chapter twelve of the Revised Statutes, and in compensation of Town Officers.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Compensation
of town offi-
cers.

SECTION 1. Supervisors, assessors, clerks of the polls and superintendents of schools, shall be entitled to a compensation for each day actually and necessarily devoted by them to the service of the town, and in the discharge of
