## Chapter 106.

## Published May 25th, 1858.

An Acr to amend chapter 54 of the general laws of 1857, entitled "An act to prevent trespasses on the swamp and overflowed lands in this State."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of said act is hereby amended as follows: Strike out all after "section 1," and insert
to chapter 54,
"The Governor of the State is hereby authorized and 1857.
empowered to cause to be surveyed the islands in the
Mississippi and Wisconsin rivers, and the unsurveyed
lands adjacent to said rivers, and the islands in any
other rivers, lakes or bays, and the swamp and overflowed lands adjacent thereto, not before surveyed,
within the jurisdiction of and belonging to this State,
granted by act of Congress, approved 28th September,
A. D. 1850, entitled "An act to enable the State of Arkansas and other States to reclaim the swamp lands
within their limits," and to do all other things he may
deem necessary to obtain from the United States, the
patents for such lands belonging to this State.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its

passage.
