

## Chapter 45.

*Published March 20th, 1858.*

AN ACT relating to Taxes and Fines due from Railroad and Plankroad Companies.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

Time extend-  
ed.

SECTION 1. That so much of chapter 74 of the general laws of 1854, entitled "an act taxing Railroad and Plankroads," as requires the said companies to pay their taxes on or before the tenth day of January in each year, together with the fines and forfeitures provided in said act, in case of a default of such payment, be and the same is hereby suspended till the tenth day of June next, for the present year.

SEC. 2. The several railroad and plankroad companies within the State, which have not paid their taxes for the present year, in pursuance of said act, shall be allowed to pay the same at any time before the tenth day of June as aforesaid; and in default of such payment, they shall be subject to the fines and forfeitures provided in said act.

How not to be  
construed.

SEC. 3. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to require the collection of said fines and forfeitures for any default made by such companies in any preceding year.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## Chapter 46.

*Published April 14th, 1858.*

AN ACT to provide for the payment of the Assistants in the Office of the Superintendent of Public Property.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

Appropriation  
to Assistant  
Superintendent.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State treasury, not otherwise appropriated,

to Bertel W. Suckow, Assistant Superintendent of Public Property, the sum of two dollars and fifty cents per day for each day's service as Assistant Superintendent of Public Property during the session of this legislature.

SEC. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to Marshall K. Leavitt, the sum of two dollars and fifty cents per day for each day's service as clerk in the office of the Superintendent of Public Property during the session of this legislature.

SEC. 3. The number of days service of the said Assistant Superintendent and Clerk shall be certified by the Superintendent of Public Property to the Secretary of State, who shall audit the same, and order the State Treasurer to pay the amount thus audited; *Provided*, The number of days service, so certified, shall not exceed the number of days actually occupied by the session of the legislature.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

## Chapter 47.

*Published March 31st, 1858.*

AN ACT to repeal Section 306 of Chapter 120 of the Laws of 1856, entitled "An Act to simplify and abridge the practice, pleadings and proceedings of the Courts of this State."

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 306 of chapter 120 of the laws of 1856, entitled "An Act to simplify and abridge the practice, pleadings and proceedings of the courts of this State," approved October 9th, 1856, is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall be published immediately, and shall thereupon take effect.
