An Act for the compensation of the Officers of the Legislature for the the year 1858.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, a sum sufficient to pay the per diem of officers of the legislature, as hereinafter mentioned, as follows : to the chief clerks, each six dollars ; to the assistant clerks, each five dollars ; and to all other clerks, each four dollars ; to the sergeants-at-arms, each five dollars ; to the assistant sergeant-at-arms, each four dollars ; to the postmasters, each four dollars ; to the assistant postmasters, each three dollars and fifty cents ; to the door-keepers, firemen and their assistants, each three dollars ; to the post-masters' messengers, each two dollars and fifty cents ; to all other messengers, each two dollars.

Appropriated to the officers of the legislature.

SEC. 2. The per diem hereby established, shall only be allowed from the commencement to the adjournment of the legislature, and each of the officers mentioned in this act, is hereby authorized to receive his per diem from the Treasury on the certificate of the presiding officers of their respective houses, as to the number of days' attendance.

Per diem only to be allowed from commencement to adjournment of the legislature.

SEC. 3. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
