AN ACT concerning exemption of property from execution.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Exempt from execution.

SECTION 1. All fire engines, apparatus and equipments, including hose, hose carts, and hooks and ladders, belonging to, or which may hereafter belong to any town, city or village in this State, and which are kept and used for the protection of property in such town, city or village from fire, together with the engine houses for the protection of the same, shall not be subject to seizure or sale upon any attachment, execution or other final process of any court, for any debt or liability of such town, city or village.

SEC 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT to repeal chapter twenty-seven of the laws of 1856, entitled "An act to annex a part of the county of Dodge to the county of Jefferson," approved March 21, 1856.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter twenty-seven of the session laws of 1856, entitled "An act to annex a part of the county of Dodge to the county of Jefferson," approved March 21, 1856, is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
