CHAPTER 187.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-one, of chapter twenty-eight, of the revised statutes.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Amendment. SECTION 1. Section twenty-one, of chapter twenty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: "All sales at auction of school, university and swamp lands, and those selected in lieu of swamp lands, shall be made at such times and at such public places as the commissioners and governor shall designate: *Provided*, that lands situated in any of the unorganized counties of this state shall be sold in said counties; and the commissioners shall, previous to any such sale, cause a notice thereof, specifying the time when and the place where the same will be held, to be published once in each week for at least eight successive weeks, in the state paper at the capital, and in each newspaper printed in the county where such lands are situated, if any; but if there is no such newspaper, then in the newspaper printed nearest to the place where such lands are located; and the expenses of such publication of notices shall be audited and paid by the commissioners out of the income of the appropriate fund.

Take effect. SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 188.

AN ACT to amend chapter eighty-six of the revised statutes, entitled "Of alienation by deed, of the proof and recording of conveyances, and the cancelling of mortgages."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Amendment. SECTION 1. Section ten, of chapter eighty-six, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "purpose," at the end of the third line of
