

CHAPTER 155.

[Published April 4, 1860.]

AN ACT conferring certain powers upon the board of supervisors of the county of Green Lake.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The county board of supervisors of the county of Green Lake shall have power, at any special or annual meeting of said board, to order and provide for the erection of a court house, jail, and such other county buildings, as may be necessary for county purposes, and to order such tax to be levied upon the taxable property of said county, as may be necessary to defray the expense of such buildings : *Provided*, that no such order shall be made, or tax levied, until two-thirds of the members of said county board of supervisors shall, at such meeting, have voted in favor thereof.

SEC. 2. All laws now in force, inconsistent with this act, are hereby declared to be inoperative upon, and not applicable to, the said county of Green Lake.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 156.

[Published March 23, 1860.]

AN ACT to authorize the Commissioners of School and University Lands to issue certain school land certificates.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The commissioners of school and university lands are hereby authorized to issue certificates for the west half of the south-west quarter of section twenty-five, town twenty, range twenty, in Calumet county, the original certificates having been lost, and there being no records of such certificate upon which they can be issued ; said certificates to be issued to the real owner, upon proper proof being made, as in cases of lost certificates.
