

CHAPTER 182.

[Published April 10, 1860.]

AN ACT providing for an increase of highway tax in the county of Richland.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Electors may vote. SECTION 1. The electors of the several towns in the county of Richland, may, at the annual town meetings held in their respective towns, order that an additional tax, not exceeding ten mills on the dollar valuation, be raised for the improvement of highways and bridges therein, and such tax, so ordered, shall be assessed, collected and disbursed in the same manner as other highway taxes in said towns.

SEC. 2 This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 183.

[Published April 9, 1860.]

AN ACT to extend the time for publication and sale of unredeemed lands in the counties of Eau Claire and Chippewa.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Time extended. SECTION 1. The time now provided by law for the sale of unredeemed lands, sold for the non-payment of taxes in the year 1856, in the counties of Eau Claire and Chippewa, is hereby extended to the eighth day of October, 1860.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
