

CHAPTER 204.

[Published April 12, 1860.]

AN ACT to authorize the Commissioners of School and University Lands to refund certain sums of money to Joseph Goldsmith.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

Interest, penalty (and fees amended.

SECTION 1. The Commissioners of School and University Lands are hereby authorized and required to refund to Joseph Goldsmith, the sum of sixty-five dollars and eleven cents, together with four dollars and fifty cents, being the amount of interest, penalty and fees, paid by said Goldsmith at a public sale of forfeited mortgaged lands, by surrendering the certificate of said sale, dated December 13th, 1859, to the said Commissioners.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
