

CHAPTER 347.

[Published April 28, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend sections one and three, of chapter 83, acts of a general nature of 1858, entitled "An act to incorporate Savings Institutions."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Sections one, of chapter eighty-three, of Amendment. the Revised Statutes, entitled "Acts of a general nature of 1858," is amended as follows, to-wit: strike out the word "nine," when it occurs in the first line, and insert the word "five;" also amend section three, by striking out the word "nine," when it occurs in the third line, and insert "five."

CHAPTER 348.

AN ACT to amend chapter 43, of the Private and Local Laws of 1859, entitled "An act to alter and establish the state road from Chilton to Menasha, and to provide for improving the same."

CHAPTER 349.

[Published April 28, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 184, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "Of inquests of the dead."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and eighty-four, of Inquests in the Revised Statutes; is hereby amended as follows: In Sheboygan to be taken by all cases when inquests are to be taken, by virtue of said coroner of that chapter, in the county of Sheboygan, the same shall be county. taken by the coroner of said county of Sheboygan, and

Powers. said coroner shall perform all the duties of taking inquests in the county of Sheboygan, defined in said chapter, and is hereby invested with all the powers of a justice of the peace in taking said inquests, as defined in said chapter, and shall have exclusive power to take such inquests in said county, except in case of inability to attend to said duty; in which case the said duty may be performed by any justice of the peace of said county.

Fee. SEC. 2. Said coroner shall be entitled to the same fee for said services as justices of the peace are, by law, entitled to in such cases.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 350.

[Published April 28, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend section 16, of chapter 7, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "Of general and special elections."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Notice of election to be published in Co. paper. SECTION 1. Section sixteen, of chapter seven, of the Revised Statutes of this State, entitled "Of elections other than for town officers," is hereby so amended as to read as follows: "And he shall also cause a copy of each such notice to be published in a paper printed in his county, once in each week, from the date of such notice, until the election, to which it shall refer, if there be a paper printed and published in his county."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
