

## CHAPTER 365.

[Published April 28, 1860.]

AN ACT to provide for the inspection of plank, gravel, and turnpike roads constructed by companies incorporated by special acts of the Legislature.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

Sections of revised statutes applied to special plank and other road charters.

SECTION 1. All the provisions of sections 39, 40, 41, 43, 44, and 45, of chapter sixty-nine, of the Revised Statutes, and chapter 202, of the General Laws of 1859, shall apply to plank, gravel, and turnpike roads constructed by companies incorporated by special acts of the Legislature, and shall have the same effect, when applied to such roads, as in the case of roads constructed by companies incorporated under chapter sixty-nine, of the Revised Statutes.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 366.

[Published April 26, 1860.]

AN ACT to provide for the exemption of insurance money on homesteads.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

Insurance money on homesteads exempted in case of fire.

SECTION 1. The owner of a homestead under the laws of this State, may insure the same from loss by fire, and in case of the burning of such homestead, no insurance company, or the agent of any insurance company, shall be liable to have any sum which may be due the owner of such homestead, from such insurance company, by reason of such burning, as aforesaid, attached in the hands of such insurance company, or agent, from whom the same may be due, by any garnishee process, or other process whatever. And all moneys arising from any such insurance policy, shall be exempt from the payment of the debts of the party insured.

SEC. 2. All acts, or parts of acts, contravening the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 367.

[Published April 28, 1860.]

AN ACT to provide for the expenditure of the drainage fund moneys in the county of Trempeleau.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. That portion of the interest of the drainage fund, which is or may hereafter become due the county of Trempeleau, shall be paid out to the county treasurer of said county, at the same time that moneys due from the school fund are paid to said treasurer, and shall be paid out by said county treasurer only on the order of the county board of supervisors of said county, as hereinafter provided.

SEC. 2. The drainage fund interest, mentioned in section one of this act, and all moneys heretofore paid to or received by said county, on account of said fund, now remaining unexpended, shall be applied and expended, under the direction of the county board of supervisors, in opening and improving such state or county roads, as may be designated by said supervisors, and for the purposes contemplated in this act, the said supervisors are hereby authorized, through their clerk and chairman, to draw orders on said treasurer, for any and all sums of money derived from said fund, that are now, or may hereafter, come into the hands of said treasurer: *Provided*, that no order shall be drawn on said treasurer for the payment of any labor that shall not have been actually performed at the time of the drawing of such order.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
