

CHAPTER 127.

[Published March 27, 1862.]

AN ACT to authorize the publication of the list of the delinquent taxes of the year 1858, in the county of Chippewa.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The time for the redemption of lands in the county of Chippewa, sold in the month of June, 1859, for the taxes of 1858, is hereby extended to the twentieth day of October, 1862; and the clerk of the board of supervisors of said county, is hereby authorized and required to publish a list of all such unredeemed lands, in the manner required by section sixteen of chapter twenty-two of the general laws of 1859, at least six months before the expiration of the time fixed by this act for redeeming said lands; and such publication and the tax deeds given for any of said lands for the taxes of 1858, shall be as legal and valid as though made at the proper time and in the proper manner, as required by chapter twenty-two of the general laws of 1859, and the acts amendatory thereof.

Redemption extended to Oct. 20th, 1862.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
