

of Ahnepee, in Kewaunee county, is hereby detached from said town of Ahnepee, and organized into a separate town, to be known by the name of the town of Lincoln, with all the powers and subject to all the rules and regulations of law which govern other organized towns in this state.

SECTION 2. The first town meeting in said town, shall be held on the first Tuesday of April, 1862, at the house of William Barnett, in said town, who is hereby authorized and required to give notice thereof, the same as town clerks are required to notice annual town meetings in other organized towns in this state.

First town meeting.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be (*be*) in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 139.

[*Published March 28, 1862.*]

AN ACT to authorize the board of supervisors for the county of Fond du Lac, to make out a list of grand jurors in said county, for the year 1862.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The board of supervisors for the county of Fond du Lac, are hereby authorized, at the next extra session of said board, to select from the poll lists of the different towns in said county, and make out in the manner (*and as*) provided in section three of chapter 118 of the revised statutes, a list of persons properly qualified to serve as grand jurors, which list of persons, when so made out, shall be the list of grand jurors for the county of Fond du Lac, for the year 1862.

Authority.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
