

CHAPTER 302.

[Published April 12, 1862.]

AN ACT to authorize the county board of supervisors of Marathon county to issue county orders for the payment of the salary of the county superintendent.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The county board of supervisors of the county of Marathon, in this state, is hereby authorized to issue orders upon the county treasurer of said county, to an amount sufficient to pay the salary of the county superintendent of schools of said county, for the year 1862. Said orders shall be drawn and paid in the same manner as provided by law for drawing and paying county orders.

Board authorized to issue orders for salary of superintendent for 1862.

SECTION 2. The board of supervisors of said Marathon county shall, at their next annual meeting, in addition to other taxes required by law to be levied, levy an amount sufficient to pay the orders authorized to be drawn in section one of this act, the same to be levied and collected as other county taxes.

Tax to be levied therefor.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 303.

AN ACT giving the board of supervisors of Grant county authority to pass an ordinance allowing horses, mules or cattle to run at large upon unenclosed lands in said county.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The board of supervisors of Grant county are hereby authorized to pass an ordinance allowing horses, mules or cattle to run at large upon lands in said county not enclosed by a lawful fence,
