

CHAPTER 55.

[Published February 28, 1862.]

AN ACT to authorize the extension of the time for the collection of taxes in the town of Windsor, in the county [of] Dane, in this state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The time for collecting the state, county ^{Extended to April 1st.} and town taxes of the town of Windsor, in the county of Dane, in this state, is hereby extended until the first day of April, A. D. 1862; and the treasurer of said town shall have the same right to levy on property and sell the same within the said time so extended, as is now allowed by law for such purposes.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.

CHAPTER 56.

[Published March 1, 1862.]

AN ACT to extend the time for collecting taxes in the town of Center, La Fayette county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The time for the collection of taxes, ex- ^{Extended to June 1st.} cept the state tax, in the town of Center, in the county of La Fayette, due for the year 1861, is hereby extended until the first day of June next, until which time the treasurer of said town, by virtue of his warrant for the collection of taxes, shall have the same power and authority to receive and enforce the payment of taxes in his town, and shall proceed in the same manner as is prescribed by law.

SECTION 2. The said town treasurer shall, on the ^{Returns and sale of delinquent lands.} first day of June next, make returns to the county treasurer of said county, of all lands upon which taxes
