CHAPTER 180.

[Published April 16, 1863.]

AN ACT relative to the sale of intoxicating liquors to mixed blood Indians.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Application of statutes.

SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter 275 of the general laws of 1862, entitled “an act relative to the sale of intoxicating liquors to Indians,” shall apply in all respects as fully to the class of persons denominated “mixed blood Indians,” who receive their annuity from the United States, as well as to Indians: *provided*, this act shall not apply to civilized persons of Indian descent, not members of any tribe.

Proviso.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
