

CHAPTER 232.

[Published April 22, 1863.]

AN ACT to provide for the payment of the chaplains of the present legislature.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated [appropriated] out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, [appropriated,] a sufficient sum to pay each of the clergyman [clergymen] officiating as chaplain at the present session of the legislature, [legislature,] twenty-five dollars. Appropriations.

SECTION 2. The chief clerks of the senate and assembly shall diliver [deliver] to each of said clergymen a certificate of such service, and such certificate shall be sufficient authority for the payment of such amount by the state treasurer. Vouchers.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 233.

[Published April 16, 1863.]

AN ACT to repeal section 27 of chapter 29, and section 36 of chapter 28 of the revised statutes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Section twenty-seven of chapter twenty-nine, and section thirty-six of chapter twenty-eight of the revised statutes, are hereby repealed. Repeal of statutes limiting quantity of state lands any one may purchase.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
