CHAPTER 276.

[Published April 23, 1863.]

AN ACT to authorize the state treasurer and secretary of state to omit from their annual reports, detailed statements of the receipts and disbursements of the war fund, the allotment fund and the fund in aid of the families of volunteers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The secretary of state and the state treasurer are hereby authorized to omit from their annual reports, detailed statements of the receipts and disbursements in the war fund, the allotment fund and the fund in aid of the families of volunteers.

Detailed statements of disbursements from war fund, may be omitted.

SECTION 2. The provisions of any acts conflicting with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
