SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 339.

[Published May 5, 1863.]

AN ACT to authorize the building of a bridge across Fox river.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The town of Aurorah, [Aurora,] in the county of Waushara, and the city of Berlin, in the county of Green Lake, are hereby authorized to build and maintain a free bridge across Fox river, on or near the section line between sections thirty-three and thirty-four, town eighteen, north of range thirteen east. Authority to build bridge.

SECTION 2. The said bridge shall be constructed with a suitable draw, so as not to interrupt the navigation of said Fox river; and the expense of repairing and tending said bridge shall be paid equally by said town and city. Draw.

SECTION 3. All the laws of this state prohibiting injuries to public bridges, or imposing penalties therefor, shall be applicable to said bridge; and the said town of Aurorah [Aurora] or the city of Berlin shall be entitled to bring suit for damages for injury to said bridge, in any of the courts of this state having jurisdiction, or to prosecute for penalties for any violation of law relating to said bridge. Application of laws.

SECTION 4. This act shall be construed to be a public act, and shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication.
