

paid taxes of 1858, and all acts and proceedings relative thereto, prior to such sale and subsequent [subsequently] to the completion of the assessment roll of 1858, is [are] hereby made legal for all purposes whatsoever; and all certificates of sale issued thereon by the city treasurer of said city of La Crosse, are hereby made legal, valid and sufficient in all respects and to all intents and purposes, and no omission or error in the advertising of said lands or in any other respect, shall, to any extent, invalidate said sale or the tax certificates or tax deeds issued thereon.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 94.

[Published March 26, 1863.]

AN ACT to legalize the sale of lands for unpaid taxes, and the advertisement thereof, in the county of Dodge.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All sales of lands for unpaid taxes, made in and for the county of Dodge, on the 9th day of September, A. D. 1862, and the advertising thereof, and all certificates of sale issued thereon by the county treasurer of said county, and the advertisement of the delinquent list in the Beaver Dam Argus, for four weeks previous [previously] to the said 9th day of September, are hereby made legal and valid, and sufficient in all respects and to all intents and purposes; and no omission or error in any of the dates in said advertisement or day of sale, shall, in any manner, invalidate any tax deed that hereafter may be given pursuant to any such certificate of sale.

SECTION 2. This act is hereby declared to be a general law, and shall take effect from and after its passage.
