AN ACT to incorporate the Berlin and Lake Superior railroad company.

CHAPTER 228.

[Published April 5, 1864.]

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter 390 of the general laws of 1862, relating to the superintendent of public property, and the purchase and distribution of stationery.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Stationery to be purchased by superintendent of public property.

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter 390 of the general laws of 1862, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: "Section 1. Chapter 27 of the revised statutes, entitled 'of the state superintendent of public property, and the purchase and distribution of stationery for the use of the state,' is hereby amended, by striking out the whole of section five of said chapter, and inserting the following in lieu thereof: 'The superintendent of public property is hereby constituted the agent of the state to purchase all stationery for the use of the state, at a compensation not exceeding five hundred dollars per annum, which agent shall let the contract every year for furnishing the said stationery to

the lowest bidder, as provided in section twenty-five of article four of the constitution. And the said agent so appointed, shall report to the legislature, during the first week of each annual session, the amount of stationery purchased by him during the next preceding year, up to the day of making such report, of whom all such stationery has been purchased, the amount of cash paid on such stationery, if any, the amount purchased on credit, if any, the amount of indebtedness against the state for stationery, if any, and to whom such indebtedness is due.' ”

SECTION 2. There is hereby annually appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of five hundred dollars, for the purpose specified in section one of this act.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
