

CHAPTER 252.

[Published April 15, 1864.]

AN ACT to vacate Gorsuch and Day's addition to the city of Hudson.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Vacated.

SECTION 1. All that addition known, described and recorded as Gorsuch and Day's addition to the city of Hudson, is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 253.

[Published April 16, 1864.]

AN ACT in relation to taxation in the city of Oshkosh.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Repeal.

SECTION 1. All that portion of section two of chapter eight of an act to revise, consolidate and amend the act to incorporate the city of Oshkosh, and the several acts amendatory thereof, approved March 22d, 1861, reading as follows: "When there are buildings upon any lot or parcel of land, the value of the same shall be set forth in a separate column," is hereby repealed; and section two of said chapter eight is hereby amended, by adding thereto the following words: "And it is hereby made the duty of the several ward assessors of said city, to correct any description or descriptions in their assessment by them made, before the tax list is handed to the city treasurer for collection."

Correction of assessment.

Repeal.

SECTION 2. All of section twenty-five of said chapter eight of the act named in the preceding section, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
